### Scope of Services

The Premium Dashboards provide a quick (primarily) visual overview of air quality data and, depending on the scope, related data. The scope of information accessible via the respective Premium Dashboard relies on the type of Premium Dashboard. The following types of Premium Dashboards are offered:

- **Basic Dashboard:** simple scope
- **Plus Dashboard:** extended scope
- **Pro Dashboard:** full scope

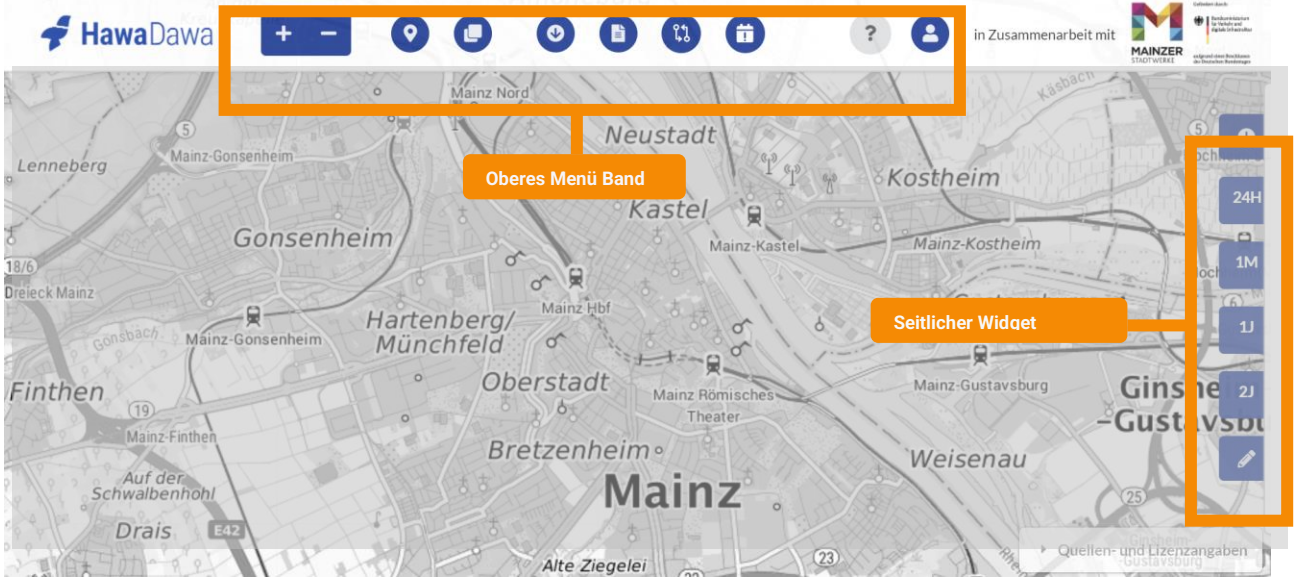

### Navigation

Each premium dashboard has two interactive areas for navigation (depending on the dashboard variant, not all submenu items are active):

- The **upper menu band** above the map view for general navigation
- The **side widget area** to work with the data of a station previously selected on the map

## The Side Widget Area

When a station is activated/clicked on the map, the widget area on the right edge expands to visually display the data of the selected station.

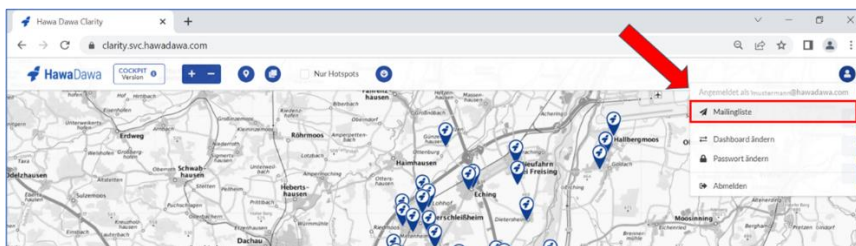
## Setting Up and Using the Mailing List

"Mailing Lists" supports both the one-time sending of a specific report and the creation of a personal mailing list that automatically sends regularly generated reports (e.g., the monthly evaluation on compliance with legal limits) to the deposited recipients each time they appear. You can add a personal comment to each e-mail.

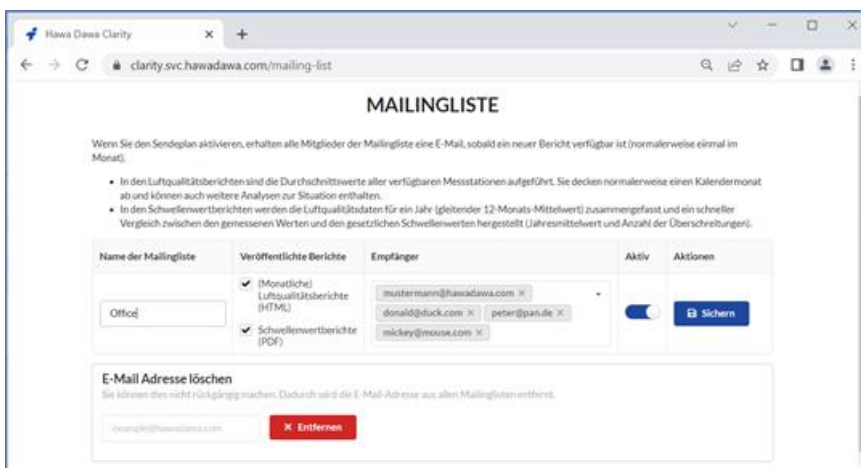
### 1.1.1 Sending report once/directly to individual recipients
